

# Review Summary

Two experienced peer-reviewers and a section editor reviewed the Stage 1 manuscript, consisting of the introduction and methods section. The section editor and both reviewers viewed the Stage 1 manuscript favorably and in line with the scope of the journal. The manuscript was given in-principle acceptance and the authors were instructed to begin their data collection and analysis, following the methods outlined in the Stage 1 manuscript.

The Stage 2 manuscript was submitted several months later. This time, a section editor and three reviewers had favorable reviews of the Stage 2 manuscript. An acceptance decision was supported and the authors were given the opportunity to address some minor, optional suggestions related to clarity.

Based on both positive peer-review processes and the criteria for publication met, I made the decision to accept this manuscript.
